On the oil side of the Accusump there is an outlet that is plumbed into the engine's oiling system, controlled by a valve. On the air side it's equipped with a pressure gauge (except for turbo oiler models) and a schrader air valve. The schrader valve allows you to add a pre-charge of air pressure to the Accusump. How do I connect the oil filter and accumulator?

Connect the oil filter, cooler and Accumulator in series as shown using -10AN lines and fittings. If a remote oil filter with a one way valve is not used, we recommend installing a one way check valve on the filter side of the accumulator. Charge the unit as described under CHARGING THE SYSTEM.

How do you lift accumulator?

Use approved lifting devices to lift and move the accumulator. Hoisting points of accumulator, see the chapter 6 Installation. If the accumulator is over 180 mm and storage time over six months, it is recommended to storage accumulators in a vertical position gas side down. This way residues of oil will keep the piston sealing lubricated.

How should a hydraulic accumulator be positioned?

Insure the hydraulic fluid is compatible with the accumulator seals/elastomers. The accumulator should be positioned as near as practical to the source of shock/pulsation, or potential energy need. Porting/piping should be matched as closely as possible to insure free flow of hydraulic fluid in and out of the application system.

How do I check the accumulator charging pressure?

Checking and adjustment of pre-charge should be performed with an accumulator charging gauge and hose assembly, such as the Tobul GG2527F (Max. 3000 PSIG) or a similar assembly with the appropriately sized pressure gauge, to correspond to system pressure.

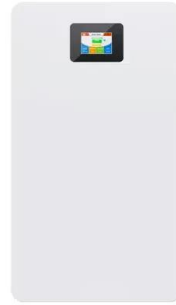


## Accusump Basics

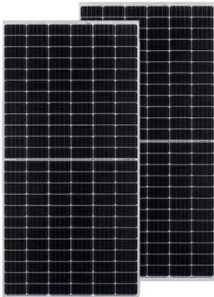
