NSW has opened the largest energy storage tender in NSW history, seeking new long-duration storage projects to boost electricity reliability and keep the lights on in NSW. These projects will help ensure a steady and reliable supply of energy around the clock. They will play a significant role in.

More than 1 GW of firmed storage capacity is set to be delivered by the six winning projects from the New South Wales (NSW) tender combining state and federal schemes. Akaysha Energy's 415 MW / 1660 MWh battery in Wellington and AGL's 500 MW / 1000 MWh Liddell battery are the round's two biggest.

The Australian federal government's 32 GW Capacity Investment Scheme (CIS) is already bearing fruit, with a competitive tender seeking 600 MW of energy storage capacity in Victoria and South Australia attracting 19,000 MW of project proposals. From pv magazine Australia Australian Federal Energy.

New South Wales' (NSW) Electricity Infrastructure Roadmap tender program will aim to procure 2 GW/16 GWh of long duration energy storage (LDES) capacity by 2030. The NSW government has launched its sixth Electricity Infrastructure Roadmap tender, seeking 1 GW of new LDES projects to boost.

The Australian federal government says it plans to launch four new big tenders for wind, solar and storage in coming months as it works to ensure that enough capacity is delivered into the country's main grids to meet its 2030 renewable energy target. The four new tenders were revealed late. What will NSW's new long-duration storage tender do?

This tender will take NSW closer to its target of 2 gigawatts of new long-duration storage by 2030. Long-duration storage serves an important role as it allows renewable energy such as solar and wind to be stored and then released on demand when needed. Projects could include pumped hydro, batteries, compressed air storage and other technologies.

When will new tenders be launched in Australia?

The new briefing from the federal government says two new tenders will be launched next month, in August, one for generation and one for dispatchable capacity and both focused on Western Australia.

Are Victorian and South Australian tenders fast tracked?

The Victorian and South Australian tender appears to have been fast tracked, with the federal government formerly flagging announcement dates in October. This tender is additional to an expanded tender currently running in New South Wales.

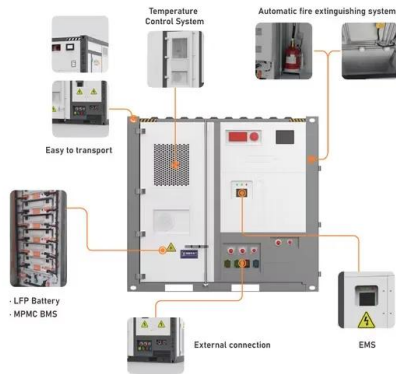
What is the Victorian-South Australian tender?

The Victorian-South Australian tender marks the beginning of a three-year national bidding schedule with competitive tenders to be held approximately every six months through to the end of 2027. The objective is to deliver 9 GW of dispatchable capacity and 23 GW of variable capacity nationwide by 2030.

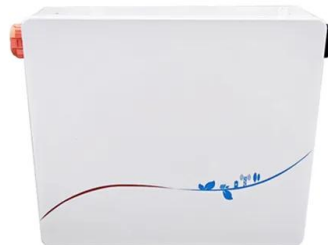

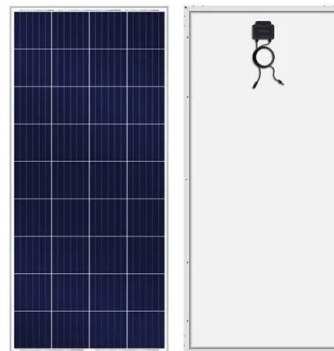
