What materials can withstand high temperatures without scorching?

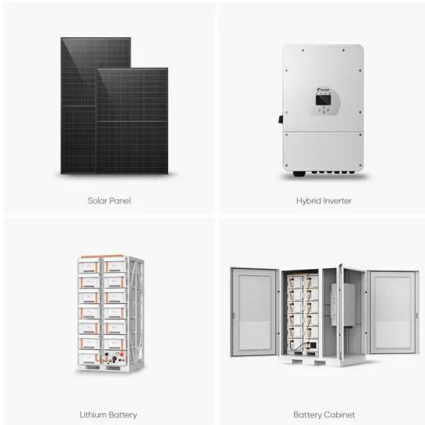

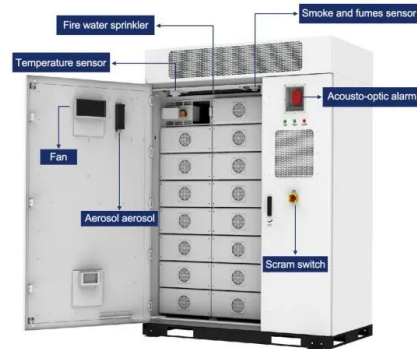
