Overview

What is the Strategic Petroleum Reserve?

Designed to protect the U.S. economy from global energy shocks, the reserve is the world's largest emergency crude oil supply. But it is currently at its lowest level in forty years, holding just under 400 million barrels.

What are crude oil stocks in the Strategic Petroleum Reserve?

Notes: Crude oil stocks in the Strategic Petroleum Reserve include non-U.S. stocks held under foreign or commercial storage agreements. Bulk terminal stocks include stocks held by merchant producers. Stocks are reported as of the last day of the month.

How many barrels are in the US Strategic Petroleum Reserve?

The United States' Strategic Petroleum Reserve reached its lowest inventory since the 1980s in July 2023, with a little under 347.5 million barrels under the Biden administration. Biden replenished some of those losses and left around 393.5 million barrels in the SPR.

When will the Strategic Petroleum Reserve be filled?

On March 19, 2020, President Donald Trump directed the Department of Energy to fill the Strategic Petroleum Reserve to maximum capacity, when oil was priced at \$24 per barrel.

What is involved in America's Strategic Petroleum Reserve?

America's Strategic Petroleum Reserve is a collection of underground salt caverns in Texas and Louisiana that can hold more than 700 million barrels of oil, although it is not currently full.

Where is the Strategic Petroleum Reserve (SPR) located?
